Additionally, we have state-of-the-art DTG (direct-to-garment) printing equipment that allows us to print highly accurate and detailed designs with an unlimited color palette on different color garments including white and/or black shirts.

During this special evening walk, 6,000 fundraising participants will gather at Cleveland University-Kansas City to enjoy a pre-walk carnival of food, entertainment, fireworks and games. Following the carnival, walkers will "Light the Night" along a leisurely-paced one-mile route by carrying illuminated lanterns — red for supporters, white for survivors and gold in memory of loved ones lost to cancer.
